Dear Parents

Notification of Partial Closure on Wednesday 15 and Thursday 16 March 2023 due to Strike Action

As you are aware we have been informed by **NEU (National Education Union)** that there will be strike action by their teacher members on **Wednesday 15** and **Thursday 16 March 2023**. The dispute is with the Secretary of State for Education with regards to the NEU view that there has been a *'Failure to provide a fully funded above-inflation pay rise (as measured by September 2022 RPI). A fully funded pay rise is one that is funded by additional resources sufficient to provide the above-inflation pay rise' (NEU).*

I have assessed the impact of the strike action on the school and have decided that the school will **only be open** for the following classes/children:

Our sincere apologies for the difficulties that these arrangements will cause parents but unfortunately these are circumstances beyond our control. The school will open as normal on **Friday 17 March and this day is a compulsory school day which your child should attend.**
