Dear Parents,

To promote reading for pleasure, to bring our world book day celebrations to a close and to encourage our children to read more broadly, we are having a pop up school book fair on **Friday 10 March**. The book fair is being organised in conjunction with our local Usborne Partner, **Anne Croxford** and every book purchased will go towards brand new **FREE** books for our school. (Usborne will also donate up to **60%** of the total book fair sales value raised in **FREE BOOKS** to the school. So, for every **£600** of books purchased, we will get **£360** in FREE Usborne books for our school!)

All classes have been timetabled to visit the book fair over the course of the day. If your child would like to purchase a book, please send some money in with your child in a clearly marked envelope with their name and class on it. This money should only be brought in on the day of the fair - Friday 10 March. World Book Day vouchers can be accepted at the Book Fair giving £1.00 off the price of any Usborne book, game or jigsaw including special offers.

The book fair will be set up in the reading hub and, in addition to the children's visits during the day, it will remain open until 4pm in order for parents to visit with their children after school. If you would like to visit please come down onto the KS1 playground (second playground) and enter through the outside door next to the reading hub. Your children will know this door as the door they use to enter the dining hall.
