



electric guitar	A rock guitar which uses an amplifier to make its sound and needs to be plugged in.	
bass guitar	A guitar with four strings which plays low (bass) notes.	
texture	Layers of sound in a song.	
ostinato	A repeated pattern sung or played in a song.	
structure	The way the music is put together.	
graphic score	A picture of music rather than real notes.
