



Key People and Events

1862	A German man called Lothar Meggendorfer made the first book with levers. The levers made different parts of the pictures move.








Simple lever




Paper fastener used as a pivot


Sliders move from side to side and up and down

Key Vocabulary

slider	A rigid bar which moves backwards and forwards along a straight line.
lever	A rigid bar which moves around a pivot. Levers are used in many everyday products such as door handles and seesaws.
pivot	Fixed point that a lever rests on.
mechanism	A device used to create movement in a product.
product	An item designed to do a particular job.
guide or bridge	A short card strip used to keep sliders in place and control movement.
slot	The hole through which a lever or slider is placed to enable part of a picture to move.
