An overview:

- Children born between 1st September 2009 and 31st August 2010
- 70,000 children across London, many of whom are transferring across borough boundaries are involved in this process
- The PAN London coordinated admissions system means all 33 London Borough's together with 5 councils bordering London, exchange information and co-ordinate admissions
- All offers are notified on the same day 1 March 2021. You will receive an email on the evening of 1 March notifying you of the outcome of your online application
- Statement of Special Educational Need, and Education, Health and Care Plan arrangements will be different and SEN Services will contact you directly
- Complete the form for the Borough you live in
- Include all the schools you want to be considered for on one form

- Address of school and name of head teacher/principal
- Dates and times of virtual open evenings
- Information on how to apply, how places are allocated and how to appeal
- Additional information for parents of children with SEND

Types of Schools

- Community the Local Authority (elected Councillors) is responsible for deciding the admission arrangements for pupils
- Foundation the School's Governing Body is responsible for deciding the admission arrangements for pupils





Types of Schools


- Voluntary Aided the School's Governing Body is responsible for deciding the admission arrangements for pupils
- Academies and Free Schools—publicly funded state schools. The Academy Council or School Governors are responsible for deciding the admission arrangements

Admission Criteria

- Rules used to decide which children are offered places when there are more applications than places available.
- Rules may differ between local authorities and types of schools.
- Check school and local authority websites in case there are any changes to the information in LA booklets





Community School Admission Criteria (summary - see booklet for full details)

- Children in public care or previously adopted
- Children for whom a particular school is appropriate on exceptional medical grounds
- Children with a brother or sister attending the school at the time of admission (living at the same address)
- Children of members of staff
- Children living nearest to the school measured as the "crow flies"





Exceptions

Chace Community – priority zone for nominated roads

Enfield County School for Girls has a quota system of allocation

Partially or Fully Selective Schools

- Selective schools aim to test children before the closing date for applications.
- Children must be registered directly with the schools to be entered for the relevant selective tests/trials/auditions
- Where possible, schools will let parents have the results of the tests/trial/audition before the closing date for the Borough application.



Partially or Fully Selective Schools

- If results are not available before 31st October closing date, you will still need to include the school in your application
- If, after receiving information about the outcome of the test, you want to change your preferred schools, you should make this request as soon as possible and no later than 9th December.

What can Enfield parents expect?

- One local authority application for all maintained schools (community, foundation, voluntary aided, free school and academy) regardless of where the school is located
- Common closing date across England for the submission of forms – 31st October 2020
- 6 Preferences across London (Hertfordshire will only accept four Hertfordshire schools – don't include more)
- Equal consideration given to each school asked for




What can Enfield parents expect?

- Enfield will apply on your behalf for schools outside the Borough.
- Late applications or changes of preference after the closing date will only be accepted in exceptional circumstances
- If your child is eligible for more than one school, the preference order will be used to decide the final offer
- Single offer emailed to parents/carers on 1st March 2021

Important information

From the 1st September 2020, you can apply for a school place for the year starting September 2021. You can apply for a place in:

- A Primary school (Reception)
- A Junior school (Year 3)
- A Secondary school (Year 7)

In some areas you can apply for a place in:

- A Nursery class or school (Age 3+)
- A University Technical College (Year 10)

On Line Applications

- It is quick and easy to do just register and follow the instructions
- You will get an email confirmation once you submit your application
- The online system checks that you are completing all the right sections of the application
- The online system is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week until midnight on the closing date



You can get your result on the evening of 1 March 2021 and either accept and decline your offer on line



Making your application

Make sure you tell us...

 If the child is looked after or adopted?



- Are there brothers or sisters attending any of the schools you are applying for?
- Does a parent work at any of the schools listed on your form?



Making your application

- Provide supporting information with your application if you are asking for medical priority
- Be sure the address you use is the child's usual place of residence. Attach details if not
- Include your council tax reference number in your application.
- Complete any supplementary forms and send them directly to the schools
- Meet all the deadlines





When you get the offer:

- Accept the place within two weeks.
- Remember you will only be given one offer
- If you do not get the school you want or one on your list you can appeal
- Details on how to appeal will be sent to you in your offer letter on March 1st
- Community schools appeals take place between April and June and usually held at the Civic Centre
- VA, Academy, Foundation and free school appeals are held with the school Governors


The furthest distance the LA offered places for admission in September 2020 on national offer day (1 March 2020).

- Distance counts for many schools and will often be a deciding factor if there are more applications than places available.




Things to remember
