## AM sessions:

- Parents should drop their children off as usual
- At 8.55am, parents should make their way down the main path to the round hall.
- At the end of the session, you will be released the same way you arrived.

## **PM sessions:**

- Parents should arrive at 1.55pm and make their way down the main path to the round hall.
- At 3.00pm, the end of the session, parents will be able to take their children home with them.
- Those children who do not have parents at the session, will be taken back to their usual collection point.

Please also note the following organisational details to ensure safety for our children and smooth running of the event:

- All parents should sign the class register on arrival.
- Parents should use adult toilets only, and need to be accompanied by a staff member. They should not take their own child to the toilet.
