Year 4 Whole class ukulele tuition September 2021

Dear Year 4 parents

Welcome back to the new academic year. I do hope you have all had a restful holiday and that the children are excited to start the new term.

I am writing to inform you that the whole class ukulele lessons with Enfield Music Service will start on Monday 20th September. Mondays will be their music/Spanish/ PE day this year so if the children want to bring their own ukulele to school this is the day to bring it. Otherwise, it may be easier to keep it at home and use the school ukulele on the day. As I wrote in a previous letter, it's not mandatory for children to have their own ukulele but it's highly recommended as it will ensure better progress if they can practise at home.

Here is a reminder of where you can purchase a ukulele.

In Enfield: The North London Music Centre, 226-228 Baker St, EN1 3JY. They will need either a soprano or tenor ukulele.

I recommend supporting your local music shop as you can always get advice from them too. Here is a link if you would like to buy one on Amazon. The price usually starts at £20 - I wouldn't recommend buying one cheaper than £17 though.

They come in many different colours but should always be brought in in a case, preferably padded or hard as the thin cases don't have much protection.

The first two weeks of music lessons the children will learn about European composers, linked to their Learning Quest, all about Europe, then ukulele will begin for two terms.

I look forward to seeing how they progress and enjoy their new instrument!
