Spanish holidays are a mixture of Christian and pagan traditions. According to Catholic tradition, Christmas is celebrated on December 25 in honor of the day Jesus was born. December 31 is New Year's Eve, or <i>Nochevieja</i> in Spanish, the time to say goodbye to the year that's coming to an end and welcome the new year. But the holiday season doesn't end there! January 6 is a very important holiday in Spain called <i>el Día de los Tres Reyes Magos</i> (known in English as Epiphany or The Wise Men).
