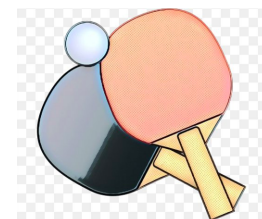
Basketball - Y2 - Y6

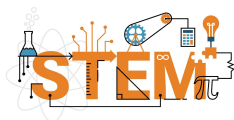
based matches. The Grange Park PE team arranges a number of matches throughout the year and we hope that every child in these clubs will represent the school.

Spanish Art and Crafts - Y1-Y6



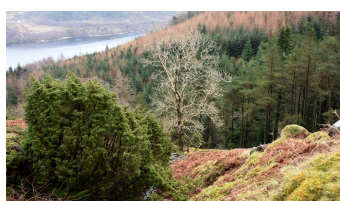
