End of Year Reports 2021/22

We are delighted to be sending home your child's End of Year Report for 2021/22 today. We hope you will be just as proud of your child as we are. The children in Years 1-6 have also completed a lovely review of their year, which we hope you enjoy reading. If you have any questions about your child's report or would like to arrange a telephone appointment with your child's class teacher please contact your child's class teacher via the office email address and they'll be more than happy to arrange a time to speak to you.

Year 2 Phonics Assessment Results

The cancellation of the phonics screening check for year 1 pupils in June 2021 meant that the year 2 children did not take their check in year 1. Therefore all children in year 2 took part in the phonics screening check in Autumn 2021. If the pupils did not meet the expected standard in the 2021 autumn check then they took another check in June 2022. You will receive your child's results today alongside your child's End of Year report.

The Phonics screening check is a short, statutory assessment to ensure that children are making sufficient progress in their phonics skills to read words and are on track to become fluent readers who can enjoy reading for pleasure and for learning.

Year 2 SATs

Your child's teacher is responsible for judging the standards your child is working at in English reading, English writing, mathematics and science, by the end of key stage 1 (Year 2). To help inform those judgements, pupils all took part in national curriculum tests in English and mathematics, commonly called SATs. The tests are a tool for teachers to help them measure your child's performance and identify their needs as they move into key stage 2. These teacher assessment judgements have been reported to you in your child's end of year report. As children develop at different rates, there will be some pupils who are achieving at, above or below the expected standard for their age. Your child's class teacher is happy to discuss this with you.

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Classes Next Year

I am pleased to share with you the class teachers for the forthcoming year (table below). We will be arranging for the children in Reception to Year 5 to have the opportunity to meet their new class teacher before the end of term.
