Play in time with the music, recognising rests.

Move between notes without squeaking.

crotchet	A one beat note.
quaver	Worth half a crotchet.
minim	A two beat note.
semibreve	A four beat note.
crotchet rest	A silence for one beat.
treble clef	Symbol showing high notes, played above middle C.
stave	The five lines music is drawn on.
bar	A section of music separated by a line on the stave.
repeat sign	Repeat a section of music .
