English

Writing

Write a 'rags to riches' tale.

Use a traditional opening and ending, organised by using box up planning formats.

Use expanded noun phrases to describe and a range of connectives to link ideas fluently.

Use 'show not tell' - engaging the reader through word choice and language.

Use paragraphs consistently and be able to justify where a paragraph should be included.

Vary sentence starts to develop control of writing.

Reading

Develop reading skills related to VIPERS.

Summarise and predict based upon a variety of texts.

Read and perform poetry.



Maths

Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations.

Read, write, order and compare numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words.

Recognise the place value of each digit in a 3-digit number. Add and subtract up to 3-digit numbers mentally/using formal written methods and estimate answers using the inverse. Multiply and divide numbers related to measures in maths. Identify properties related to 2d and 3d shape.

Make links between 2d shapes as faces of 3d shapes using nets. Identify fractions of shape and number.

Solve multiple step problems related to all four operations, shape and factions.



History

Ancient Civilisations

Place historical civilisations on a timeline giving examples for each.

Know key people and places of Ancient civilisations.

Use world maps to identify where the four civilisations were

Research key information about the four civilisations and identify similarities and differences between them.

achievements of each civilisation.



D&T

3D shell construction

Design and build an Egyptian keepsake box.

Explore the features of Ancient Egyptian containers.

Investigate how materials and joins can be strengthened by using an L-brace, corrugating and layering card.

Investigating appropriate nets for a container.

Measure, mark out and cut nets of 3D shapes with accuracy.

Use appropriate tools and equipment for cutting and scoring card.

Investigate different mechanisms for attaching lids.

Complete a design, including a drawing with labels.

Evaluate and analyse the finished product.

Make changes to the design to build an improved keepsake box, with a design inspired by another ancient civilisation.





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Science

Light

Explore how we need light to see things and why some things are easier to see than others.

Draw diagrams to explain our understanding of how light travels. Investigate how different objects reflect different amounts of light.

Design and produce reflective strips for night safety. Explain how a mirror works and describe how images in mirrors may look 'different'.

Identify what affects the shape and size of a shadow.



RE

Judaism

The Torah and stories of the Jewish people.

Explore how Jewish principles are shared through community and beliefs.

Develop the skill of using specialist vocabulary to communicate knowledge and understanding of Jewish beliefs, teachings, practices and symbols.



Computing

Video trailers and digital literacy

Develop filming and editing video skills through the storyboarding and creation of book trailers.

Apply digital video skills to create book trailers using sequenced frames. Learn to create a storyboard.

Identify key events within a book. Frame and film shots.

Edit a film, adding effects such as transitions, music, voice and text. E-safety: Understand the rules of

social media platforms.

Respond to different stimuli to create motifs. Execute a wide variety of movements in extended sequences.

Tennis

Develop knowledge and skills related to tennis.
Use equipment (racquets) effectively.
Learn how to produce a forehand shot.
Develop ways to make space and play winning point shots.

Listen to, play and compose music with pentatonic scales.
Use notation to play glockenspiels.
