^{*}For example: A year 3 pupil would need to be dropped off at 12:30pm for rehearsal time and then would perform their dance in front of parents and pupils on the field at 1:00pm.

Pupils will need to come to the fayre dressed ready for their performance, in their suggested colours that will be informed by the class teacher. You will be informed of the suggested colour and theme this week via parentmail.

Your children will meet their teachers at their designated year 3 classroom and from here they will practice their routine one last time before heading down to the field in front of yourselves. Pupils will not return into the school building after the performance and they will leave the stage area to meet yourselves in the signed pick up area.

It is vitally important that pupils arrive prior to the rehearsal time in order to ensure the performances run according to the timetable.
