National Gallery

Year 2 have planned an exciting visit to the National Gallery in Trafalgar Square as part of our learning quest topic: Mad for Madagascar. The purpose of this visit is to observe paintings and artists, particularly the work of Henri Rousseau through a guided tour and to learn more about the artists behind the work.

Puffin Class and Woodpecker Class will be visiting the National Gallery on **Thursday 21st April 2022**. Kingfisher Class and Robin Class will be visiting the National Gallery on **Friday 22nd April 2022**. We will be travelling by tube. You will need to bring your child to Oakwood station. Your child's class teacher will meet you at Oakwood station at 9.15am for registration and a prompt departure. We will return to Oakwood station at 3.10pm where you will need to collect your child from. Please drop off and collect your child from Oakwood station (not school) on the day of the trip. If your child usually attends breakfast club in the morning, they will be taken to Oakwood on the mini bus. If they are in Extend after school or an enrichment club, they will be dropped off to the school on mini bus

The cost of this trip is **FREE.** Your child should wear their school uniform and ensure they have a suitable coat and footwear.

Your child is entitled to Universal Free School Meals so the school can provide a packed lunch which will consist of a cheese sandwich, a piece of fruit *or* a mini muffin and a bottle of water or you can provide your own packed lunch in a labelled plastic bag (no nuts, fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). Please indicate whether your child will require a school packed lunch by **12.00 pm on Friday 1st April**.

If you are available and would like to accompany us on the trip, please express your interest on Parentmail and your class teacher will confirm parent volunteers once all responses have been submitted.

All children on our asthma register must make sure they have an up to date pump with them on the day. Children without their pumps will not be allowed to go.
