
Use expanded noun phrases in writing by the addition of modifying adjectives, nouns and prepositional phrases.

Maths

Find numbers more or less than given numbers up to 1000. Order and compare numbers (including negative numbers). Round numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000.

Recall multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12x12.

Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator. Recognise and write decimal equivalents of 'ths' and 'hths' Round decimals and solve simple measure problems involving fractions.

Estimate, compare and calculate different measures, including money in pounds and pence

Geometry:

Identify the properties of both 2D and 3D shapes. Measure and calculate the perimeter and area of rectilinear shapes and basic compound shapes.



History

Explain why lots of people sharing the same opinions or beliefs online does not make those opinions or beliefs true.


