**Re: Relationships and Sex Education (RSE) Parent Workshop: Thursday 19 May 2022 (EYFS & KS1) and Thursday 26 May (KS2)**

As part of your child's education at Grange Park, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. PSHE education is the curriculum subject that gives children the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy and productive lives and meet their full potential.
