Year 6 have planned an exciting visit to **Bletchley Park** in Milton Keynes as part of our topic about World War II. The purpose of the visit will be to explore, experience and enjoy the once top-secret world of iconic code-breaking Huts and Blocks set within an atmospheric Victorian estate.

Lowry and Picasso will be visiting Bletchley Park on **Wednesday 22 November 2023**, and **Kandinsky and Monet** will be visiting Bletchley Park on **Thursday 23 November 2023**. We will be travelling by coach. The children will be leaving school promptly at 8:15am so they will need to be in school by 8.00am at the very latest. We will return at 3.30pm, slightly later than the normal school day pick up, in order to give the children the maximum experience at the venue.

Your child should wear their school uniform and ensure they have a warm coat.

If you are available and would like to accompany us on the trip, please express your interest on ParentMail by 3.00 pm on Monday 6th November and your class teacher will confirm parent volunteers once all responses have been submitted.

All children on our asthma register must make sure they have an up to date pump with them on the day. Children without their pumps will not be allowed to go.
