### **The Big Help Out**

To mark His Majesty The King's Coronation in May, thousands of organisations across the country are getting together to give us all the chance to help out in our own local communities.

Community Volunteering is an important part of the UK's story, from Air Raid Wardens during the Second World War, to over 12 million of us who stepped forward during the pandemic.

Now thousands of organisations – big and small – are getting together to mark The King's Coronation by giving everybody the chance to try volunteering for themselves and make a difference in their community.

The Big Help Out officially starts on Monday 8th of May and Grange Park will be taking part during the summer term.
