Coach travel to Voice in a Million on 15 March 2023

It is not long until Voice in a Million – only 8 weeks! I am writing to inform you of the cost of the coach travel and how to help your children practise at home.

The cost of travel to Wembley SSE arena is £13 per child payable via Parentmail > Payment Item > Shop > Coach Travel VIAM. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium or has Free School Meals the school can support you. Please make payment by 12.00 pm on Wednesday 22 February.

If you have bought tickets to come and see the concert then it's expected that you collect your child afterwards in a designated meeting area. I will inform you where this is nearer the time. We will travel on two coaches but return on one 70 seater so it's vital that you confirm how your child will travel home. Please complete the simple form below.

Learning the lyrics

There are two ways the children can practise the songs and dance moves at home. One is by opening the slides on Google Classroom in the music folder.
