If you wish to register your child for our Entrance Examination and/or Musical Aptitude Tests you need to:-

- Read our Admissions Arrangements for Secondary Transfer 2020 available to view on the Admissions Section of our website.
- Ensure your child's permanent address falls within one of the Local Priority Areas detailed below Only children living within our Local Priority Areas at the closing date of registration are eligible to sit our entrance tests children who live outside of these areas will not be able to sit our tests.
- Ensure your child is available for the dates of the tests:

Monday 2nd September 2019 (Verbal Reasoning). The top 325 candidates will be invited back on Saturday 28th September 2019 to sit English and Maths tests.

Tuesday 3rd September 2019 (First Round Musical aptitude)

One further date will be arranged, if necessary, for medical/religious reasons ONLY. NB. We are unable to accommodate children whose holiday commitments clash with our tests or for any other reason than those previously stated.

• Complete the online Test Registration Form - available on the school website from <u>9 am on 15th May until 6 pm on 19th June 2019</u>. Children can be registered at any time during this four week period – there is no advantage in registering early. Please note we are unable to accept ANY late registration requests.
